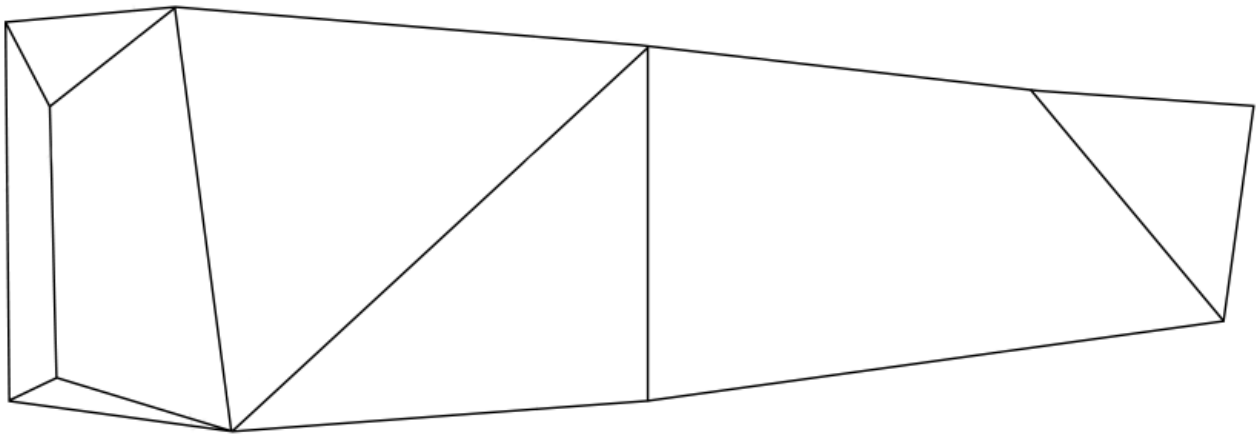

Design is orientation. Design is differentiation. The kitchens from Steininger set high quality requirements, they stand out clearly and set standards that move. The same applies to the new kitchen model FOLD at STEININGER. FOLD is a form-strong statement with cubistic tombac surface, a rose gold shimmering brass places. The alloy is made using a computer-based method in millimeter fraction precisely prepared and perfected by hand. Encased this way the iconic kitchen seems to float. The design is clear, purist, simple and yet highly functional. The kitchen model FOLD will also be available in other metals and alloys.

LIVING SPACE KITCHEN

Kitchens are the center points of a home. Often they are linked to the living space, creating a central place for cooking, meeting and relaxing. The modern food factory is no longer just focused on cooking. This development has something to do with the changed perception of this topic. For a long time cooking was just a necessity, nowadays it has gained a certain level of prestige and appreciation. Who cooks takes time, focuses, finds peace after a working day. The enjoyment of food and cooking is in the foreground. ICONS OF THE KITCHEN

Puristic elegance and a shiny metal look characterize the appearance of the new kitchen model FOLD at STEININGER. A precise computer-based selected Manufacturing technology shapes the metal materials of different shades into a fascinating kitchen object. The design language of the kitchen block reminds you of the art of paper folding. FOLD is a dormant geometric body that withdraws its power, but not its presence. The bright, warm brass tone creates an exciting game with the light on the sloping surfaces. With FOLD Steininger presents the kitchen in the usual way: as a sculptural object. One would think the function follows the form, but the form knows how to conceal the function. Behind the puristic aesthetics lay smooth drawers, technical refinements and exciting details.
